- 3. Luke Taiclet made a motion, seconded by Kim Wagner to purchase dog clean up stations for the park and wetlands for no more than \$500 placed in the budget to come out of the Dominion for Park Funds (clarified from West Loop) in 2022. Roll Call Vote Yes: Bart Carr, Roz Miller, Kim Wagner, Luke Taiclet, and Michelle Joy.
- 5. Roz Miller made a motion, seconded by Bart Carr to approve the 14-2021 Tax Rate Resolution for 2022 (12.5 Mills). Roll Call Vote Yes: Bart Carr, Roz Miller, Kim Wagner, Luke Taiclet, and Michelle Joy. All in favor, motion carries.
- 6. Roz Miller made a motion, seconded by Bart Carr to approve the 2022 Employee Holidays. Roll Call Vote Yes: Bart Carr, Roz Miller, Kim Wagner, Luke Taiclet, and Michelle Joy. All in favor, motion carries.
- 7. 2021 Christmas Dinner Michelle Joy advised Shannon Steele's firm will be catering a Christmas dinner prior to the next meeting.

1. Property for the Wallace Run Lift Station – Chad Crawford discussed with Council the Wallace Run Lift Station and requested the Borough do an appraisal on the property. Shannon Steele advised with eminent

domain you would still need the appraisal. After discussion, Jennifer Gasser will reach out for additional quotes on appraisals.

Chad Crawford discussed with Council a right of way on Midvale Road. There is a tree that a resident wants removed. The Borough does not receive liquid fuels for this road/right of way and in looking at the deed, it was not adopted by the Borough. Shannon Steele advised if it was not fully adopted, it's not on liquid fuels and the Borough is not maintaining it, we have nothing to do with it.
